For this reason, Castellón continues to be one of the favourite holiday destinations for Spanish people, who are attracted to the peace and tranquillity of its tourist destinations as well as the easy transport links provided by both the A7 motorway and the extensive rail network, which connects the province.

Vinarós, Peñíscola, Alcalá-Alcossebre, Oropesa del Mar, Benicasim and Castellón de la Plana are all well-known destinations, very popular with visitors thanks to their excellent beaches combined with the authentic Mediterranean cuisine. This includes dishes such as the classic paella and a wide range of regional products, with highlights such as the langoustines from Vinaròs, artichokes from Benicarló, fresh sole from Peñíscola, and Alcalá tomatoes.

In addition, if you travel inland - less than an hours' drive - you can discover picturesque rural areas such as Morella, Sant Mateu, Segorbe, Montanejos and learn about the centuries-old crafts of olive oil production, traditional sweets and nougat, almond cultivation and enjoy the hearty stews and meats typical of local cooking. The latter still complement the classic Mediterranean cuisine, making use of the excellent and varied local produce available from the farms, orchards and fishing ports throughout the region.

Castellón is the second most mountainous province in Spain, with a wealth of natural parks, rivers and sites for enjoying leisure and sports activities. The landscape makes it especially popular for cycling - both road and mountain bikes.

Added to all this, the region has a rich cultural heritage, the result of the numerous settlements and civilizations that have populated the land over the centuries, with relics from the Moorish, Jewish and Templar societies still clearly visible in its castles and the streets of its historic old town centres.

Because of all this, we can proudly say - without fear of bias - that Castellón is one of the great destinations on the Spanish Mediterranean that we should all experience.

As a mainly coastal destination, the Province of Castellón presents a diverse and extensive range of cultural, natural and gastronomic experiences. It offers great value for your clients and plenty of attractive opportunities for additional excursions to add to your travel offers.

To assist with planning, we have sub-divided the excursions with the easiest access from the Costa Norte (Vinarós, Peñíscola y Acocebre) and the Costa Sur (Oropesa, Benicasim and Castellón).

Castellón is home to some of the most charming historic towns and villages in Spain. A fine example is Morella, a legendary small town built on the top of a mountain, surrounded by a historic fortress wall. Famous for its superb cuisine and ideally located close to the north coast.

The San Jose Caves in Vall D'Uxo are the site of the largest navigable subterranean river in Europe. A natural wonder more than two

hundred million years old, located in the south of the Province. An excursion that would combine well with any of the accommodation on offer.

The Antipope Benedict XIII (Papa Luna), the Knights Templar ...and more recently Game of Thrones; Peñíscola is undoubtedly a cult destination and an essential stop for all clients. The XIII century castle, the fish market, the old town and the extensive promenade all merit a visit in the company of an experienced guide, who will explain the history and legends of this marvellous place.

Castellón is full of walking paths designed for the enjoyment of its woods and nature. We offer one of these at Montanejos, with the added attraction of its swimming pools at the start and end of the walk. There is a natural pool that stays pleasantly warm all year round. We especially recommend this trip into the interior from accommodation in the south of the Province, as well as the Las Palmas Desert - where we can enjoy a visit to the Carmelite Wineries.



EXCURSION TO Morella

Morella is officially listed and widely considered one of the most picturesque towns in Spain. Historically important, it was built on a mountain and surrounded by a fortified wall more than two kilometres long.

We will make our way directly to Morella with a technical stop to stretch the legs. Depending on the time of day, on either the outward or return trip we will pass through the memorable landscape of la Vallibona, part of the Tinença de Benifassà Natural Park.

Once we reach Morella, we will enter the town through the San Miguel Gate, which will lead to a fascinating walk through the main streets. Our guide will explain the background of each building and its role in the history of Morella until we reach the Santa María church, which we will visit.

The Archpriest Church of Santa María la Mayor is a gothic construction with notable architectural features such as the Door of the Apostles and the Door of the Virgins on the same facade. Inside, to the rear of the choir, is the carved frieze of the

Portal of Glory. On the 28th June 1700, Pope Innocent XII granted the Morella church the honoured right of affiliation with the Archbasilica of Saint John Lateran in Rome.

After the visit, we will have some free time providing the opportunity to visit the Castle or some of the spots that offer spectacular views of Morella and the surrounding countryside. We will then meet up again at a popular restaurant to sample some of the classic dishes of Morella regional cuisine. Finally, there will be time to walk around the local shops and perhaps purchase some typical Morella products before the return trip to our respective accommodation.

EXCURSION TO Peñíscola

Peñíscola is situated on the north coast of the province of Castellón de la Plana, in the Bajo Maestrazgo shire, and is considered one of the prettiest towns in Spain.

The town was built on a peninsular on the shore of the Mediterranean, Peñíscola has one of the longest beaches on the Costa de Azahar (the Orange Blossom Coast). It is dominated by the 13th century castle originally built by the Knights Templar that became the residence of the Antipope Luna, Benedict XII.

Discover Peñíscola with a walk through its cobbled streets and breathe in the history of its alcoves. The town has been immortalized in numerous films and television series, including Game of Thrones. You can also enjoy its shops and leisure parks and the full range of additional services on offer. Departure from the Hotel direct to Peñíscola.

On arrival, we will visit the port and fish market and then take a walk through the old town, enjoying the spectacular views of the Mediterranean. We will experience at first-hand what the locals call the "Bufaor", the sound of the waves

breaking on the cliffs on which Peñíscola is built.

We will then visit the Templar Castle, residence of Pope Luna. Finally, we will re-join the coach and take a panoramic drive along the magnificent coastline of the city.

There will be free time to enjoy the beaches or the shops of Peñíscola, and at the end of the trip, we will return to our departure point.

EXCURSION TO Vall d'Uixó & Grutas de San José

La Vall d'Uixó has been inhabited since prehistoric times, as we can see from the cave paintings at the town. There are also relics from the Iberian settlements and well-documented evidence of subsequent Roman, Visigoth and Moorish occupation. The Vivel Palace, the churches of Santo Ángel and la Asunción, the San José and Alcudia aqueducts are just a few of the features of the town. The San José Caves are a natural treasure and include the longest navigable subterranean river in Europe. Come with us and enjoy these marvellous locations.

We will leave the hotel and head to La Vall d'Uixó. During the route, we will pass through the Las Palmas Desert and make a stop at a fantastic viewpoint, a balcony to the Mediterranean, from which we can look over the ruins of the ancient Carmelite Monastery that gives the location its name and enjoy one of the finest vistas of the Mediterranean coast. From there looking towards La Vall d'Uixó we will also have a panoramic view of two of the province's riches, the Mar de Naranjas (Sea of Oranges) and the impressive ceramics factories, for which the province of Castellón is

internationally famous. On arrival at La Vall d'Uixó we will go straight to the nearby San José Caves.

The coach will let us off by the restaurants, cafes and souvenir shop area, where we will have a break for a cool drink, to buy a souvenir or see the Iberian village situated above the Caves. The visit to the Caves themselves will be an unforgettable experience. Created by nature more than two hundred million years ago, they house the longest subterranean river in Europe. We will take a boat trip and the friendly boatmen will explain the various chambers as we pass by and the histories and legends surrounding them. At the end of the trip, we will return to our departure point.

EXCURSION TO Segorbe, Navajas y el Salto de la Novia

Segorbe is the capital of the Alto Palancia shire where History, Culture, Tradition and Nature all combine. Built on the Cerro de Sopeña hill, archaeological findings show evidence of inhabitants as far back as 1550 BC. It has been home to Romans, Visigoths, Moors and Christians. Since 559 AD, it has been an episcopal seat, as documented in the historic town records. Legendary heroes such as El Cid have passed through its streets and its palaces have been the residences of such figures as the Moorish Governor of Valencia Zayd Abu Zayd and the King of Aragon Martin I "the Elder".

The importance of Segorbe in the history of Spain is undisputable. We will visit the medieval old town, see the remains of the city walls and arrive at the Plaza del Agua Limpia, the town centre. From there we will visit the Santa María Cathedral, built in the gothic style with later neoclassical additions. The interior houses seven chapels and a beautiful cloister. The archives include a valuable codex and there is a lovely collection of paintings in the chapter house.

At the end of the visit, there will be time to look around the Cathedral Crypts, the Museum and the cylindrical towers of the Botxí (executioner) and the Jail, which formed part of the old wall together with the Arco de la Verónica, or make a purchase in the numerous shops around the area. We will then go on to the restaurant and sample some of the gastronomic specialities of Segorbe.

After lunch, we will move on to the nearby town of Navajas and arrive, after a pleasant stroll, at the impressive natural stopping point known as the Salto de la Novia (the Bride's Jump). This is one of the most beautiful and emblematic locations in the Valencia Region, with views over the spectacular Brazal Waterfall with its 60 metre drop where the waters cascade down the paths formed by millennia of erosion through the mountains.

At the end of the trip, we will return to our departure point.

EXCURSION TO *Traiguera & Sanctuary*

Traiguera is situated to the north of the province of Castellón, in the heart of the Baix Maestrat shire. Its origins can be traced back to the Iberian era -when it was known as "Thiar Julia" - and has been subsequently occupied by the Romans, the Visigoths, the Moors and Christians. Strategically important in the Middle Ages, Traiguera has witnessed significant historic events, successively belonging to the Knights Hospitaller and Montesa Military Orders when it reached the height of its splendour. During the 18th and 19th centuries, it played a decisive part in the War of Spanish Succession and the Carlist Wars.

The history of the Royal Sanctuary of Nuestra Señora de la Fuente de la Salud begins at the end of the 14th century when some humble shepherds found an image of the Virgin in a spring and erected a chapel over it. The fame of this miraculous spring grew to such an extent that leading Spanish figures such as Pope Alexander VI and Kings Carlos V and Felipe II sponsored the construction of the magnificent Sanctuary that we can still admire today, the only royally protected Sanctuary in the entire province.

The complex consists of various buildings housing some magnificent works of art. The Sanctuary became a National Cultural Heritage Site (BIC) classified as a Historic Artistic Monument in 2007.

We will travel on the coach to the town of Traiguera. On route, we can enjoy a panoramic view of the agricultural wealth of the region, largely based on olive groves, some of which date back centuries to the time of the Roman occupation. We will pass through the town of San Jorge, which will welcome us through its Triumphal Arch, built in 1995 by local artists. On arrival at Traiguera, we will enjoy a brief walk around town and see its principal monuments: the San Vicente Chapel, the Hermitages of San Jaime and San Blas and the Church of la Asunción. We then move on to the Royal Sanctuary consisting of the Guesthouse, the Chaplains' House and the Palace of Duke Alfonso of Aragon.

At the end of the visit, we will return to the hotel.



EXCURSION TO Montanejos

After breakfast, we will set off for Montanejos, first passing through the Roman town of Sagunto enjoying panoramic views of its principal monuments.

On the journey to Montanejos we will pass through the basin of the River Mijares, which feeds numerous water pools, and see the narrow straits formed by the river as it passes through the Maimona barrancos, or ravines. This area is now home to internationally popular rock climbing sites and natural bathing pools filled by the fountains known as los Baños, la Cerrada and la Zorrilla.

The best-known local stop-off point is La Fuente de los Baños. This warm spring produces water at a temperature of 20-25 degrees throughout the year with renowned mineral and medicinal properties.

These waters are directly channelled to the Montanejos Spa. The Spa offers a range of treatments including warm water and mud baths and massages. Depending on the time of year, it may be possible to stop off and enjoy a bathe in the natural pools during the route along the Rio Mijares towards Montanejos, as well

as the waters of the Fuente de los Baños.

The most interesting walking path is la Bojera, a circular route (seven kilometres round trip), where nature lovers can enjoy the panoramic views of the Barranco de la Maimona, and the Cueva Negra at the end of the path. During the return to our departure point, we will stop off at the Morrón de Campos, from which you can see over the entire Mijares valley.

EXCURSION TO Vilafamés

Discovering Vilafamés is like reaching up to the skies. The town is raised on a mass of red rock in the Sierra de les Conteses and this privileged position offers one of the best views over the plains and surrounding landscape. Thanks to its rich historical heritage, it was declared a National Heritage Site in 2005 and has recently been listed as one of the prettiest towns in Spain.

This area has seen human settlements since time immemorial; Neanderthals, Iberians, Moors and Christians have successively sought refuge and established residence in this location. In the Moorish era, it was known as Beni-Hamez before being re-conquered by King Jaime I. The medieval castle was built over the old Moorish fortress and was considered impregnable in its day. The picturesque streets and palaces invite a leisurely stroll and its local residents traditionally offer a warm welcome to travellers.

On our trip, we will visit the Vilafamés Castle, of Moorish origin and subsequently headquarters of the Montesa Military Order following the Reconquista. We will see the Roca Grossa, an impressive geological

formation weighing over 2000 tons and 222 million years old, standing in the middle of town, as well as other local monuments. These include the Parochial Church of la Asunción, the Palau de Batlle and the Plaza del Ayuntamiento with its magnificent stately houses, before passing through the Quartijo, the medieval neighbourhood that surrounds the town.

We will complete the trip with a visit to one of the most prestigious wineries in the region, Bodegas y Viñedos MAYO GARCÍA, and receive a complementary bottle of one of their famous estate wines. We will end the morning with some free time to shop or sample some of the excellent tapas on offer in Vilafamés.



EXCURSION TO *Desierto De Las Palmas*

We will begin our excursion to Benicàssim along the road through the Las Palmas Desert Natural Park. The Park received its title from the Carmelite monks who named the spaces around their spiritual retreats "Holy Deserts", while the name "Palmas" originates from the abundance of the only type of palm tree endemic to Europe, the palmetto (*Chamaerops humilis*).

We will make a stop in the Desert to see the ruins of the original Carmelite monastery. Torrential rain virtually destroyed the early building initially forcing the monks to abandon the site. Years later, they constructed a new monastery using many of the original stones and materials. This spot offers one of the most impressive views of the Costa de Azahar, looking down over the town of Benicàssim and the city of Castellón. On a clear day one can see as far as the Columbretes Islands - 50km out to sea. After this stop, we will go on to visit the new Monastery.

After a look around the monastery, we will carry on down to Benicàssim and visit the Carmelite Wineries. The wineries originally served to provide revenue for the monks in order to

pay for the study and training of their novices. With this in mind, the monks started to produce and sell a distinctive aromatic drink using the local herbs from the hills around the Desierto de las Palmas. They installed stills in the cellars of the Monastery and the first bottles of liquor went on sale at the end of the 18th century. By the early 20th century, the lack of adequate transport routes led to the distillery moving to its current location in the town of Benicàssim.

After this visit we will return to our departure point.

EXCURSION TO Castelló

Castellón is surrounded by orange groves, and the fruity aroma permeates the streets. This attractive city is the capital of the Plana Alta shire and still preserves the sedate and friendly character of working locations. There are three distinctive parts of town: the historic centre, the more modern surrounding neighbourhoods and, next to the sea, the Grao or port area.

We will start our trip at the Parque Ribalta, one of the most emblematic sites of the city, declared a "historic and artistic complex" in 1981. The combination of architectural design and vegetation make it one of the most impressive public gardens in the country. Leaving the Park, we will move on to the magnificent Neo-Moorish style Post Office building. We will then see the statue of King Jaime I, the work of the sculptor Viciano. We will continue on to the Plaza del Ayuntamiento where we can admire a collection of the most symbolic Castellón buildings, the Town Hall itself, the Co-Cathedral of Santa María, the Fadrell, the characteristic bell tower separate from the church, and the elegant Central Market building.

There will then be free time to either visit the buildings or the surrounding shops and restaurants. We will meet up again and move on to the port of Castellón, El Grao. The maritime neighbourhood of Castellón de la Plana, El Grao, is the city's gateway to the sea. La Plaza del Mar stands out as the meeting point for the locals or Castellonenses, "Graueros" and visitors. We will visit the commercial fishing port and have free time to walk around the open-air Mercado, that goes back to the time of King Jaime I, who authorized this type of market so typical of the Valencia Region. Moreover, for those looking to sample Castellón cuisine, the maritime district is the best place for seafood.

At the end of the trip, we will return to the departure point.



EXCURSION TO Valencia - Historic Valencia

Valencia, the third largest city in Spain and regional capital, is some 70 kilometres to the south of Castellón. After breakfast, our staff will pick you up from the hotel for the trip to the city of Valencia.

After an outside view of the Bioparc, one of the largest wildlife parks in Europe, we will move on to the City of Arts and Sciences. Built by the old riverbed of the river Turia, this is a succession of spectacular buildings designed by Santiago Calatrava; the Príncipe Felipe Science Museum, the Oceanogràfic Aquarium, L'Hemisfèric, a combined planetarium, laserium and cinema, the L'Agora events centre and the Palacio de la Música for classical concerts and theatre.

In the company of our guide we will stroll around the most interesting sites in the centre of Valencia; the modernist and decorative Estación del Norte, the Plaza del Ayuntamiento, the seat of municipal government and the Post Office - famous as the location from which the mascletàs (pyrotechnics) are set off and the largest of the fallas is set alight during the world famous town fiestas - the Miguelete, the Valencia

Cathedral bell tower and the Cathedral itself which houses a Holy Chalice claimed to be the cup used at the Last Supper. We will stop at a restaurant and enjoy a pre-booked lunch. Our guide will then give us a tour that will include both majestic buildings and interesting side streets. We should remember that for centuries Valencia was the largest port in the Mediterranean, leaving a cosmopolitan legacy and a cultural heritage that you will discover more about during the trip.

We will end our walk at the Puerta de Serranos, one of the remaining medieval city gates. Our coach will meet us there and take us to Alboraya. There we will visit a craft brewery. You will get the chance to learn how they make the beer at first hand and enjoy a tasting. If you like it, you can purchase a few bottles of Valencia craft beer on site. We will then return to your accommodation.



EXCURSION TO *Tortosa & Delta del Ebro*

From where we will be able to observe the importance of nature and agriculture to this territory, its rice fields and diversity of bird life. We will visit the Delta del Ebro Interpretation Centre where they will give an audio-visual presentation on the various species of birds and the natural richness of this unique ecosystem.

We will move on to the wharf, where we will have a short break to visit the local shops and buy some souvenirs if you wish. At the agreed time, we will set off on a boat trip to the Isla de Buda, located in the mouth of the river Ebro, which at 5 km long is the largest island in Cataluña. During the excursion, they will explain the importance of this island and we will see the old iron lighthouse, which dates from 1864, designed by the Spanish architect and engineer Lucio del Valle (1815-1874). It stood for nearly 100 years before being destroyed by a storm in 1961. This huge lighthouse, originally 53 metres high, was built on a sand bank in an unpopulated area. After the visit, we will go to a traditional local restaurant and enjoy some of the gastronomic specialities of the Delta del Ebro.

After lunch, we will move on to Tortosa, capital of the Del Bajo shire. Tortosa is an episcopal seat and an important agricultural, commercial and industrial centre. Tortosa has a special charm: its streets, its people, the historical and artistic heritage and its surrounding countryside, on the banks of the river Ebro.

We will admire the famous Castillo de Zuda, which became a property of the Crown in 1294, when the Señoría de Tortosa passed into Royal hands, and it was converted into a royal palace. It now features on the Paradores de Turismo official list of fine hotels and restaurants.

We will visit the Jardines del Príncipe, situated in the old Tortosa spa, where we will see an important collection of works by the famous sculptor Santiago de Santiago, jointly titled "Man, his motivation and destiny".

After the trip to Tortosa, we will return to our point of departure.

Valencia International Airport is located to the west of the City of Valencia (València in the Valencian language), just 8 kilometres from the city, between the towns of Manises and Quart de Poblet, explaining why it is popularly known as Valencia-Manises Airport or just Manises Airport.

The airport primarily serves the Air Nostrum (an Iberia Regional franchise), Vueling and Ryanair airlines, all of which have bases at the airport. One should also highlight the number of General Aviation private and charter flights, as well as agriculture related airfreight.

The main destinations are the airports of Madrid-Barajas, Palma de Mallorca, Barcelona-El Prat and Seville, while the principal international destinations are France (Paris), UK (London), Italy and Holland, among others.

The Airport has a single runway with 12/30 orientation, and comprises two passenger terminals: the Main Terminal building, divided into T1 and T2, where national and international flights operate; and the Regional Aviation Terminal, exclusively for local flights. There is also a General Aviation Terminal and a cargo terminal.

Runway

The airport has one runway 69 feet above sea level: Runway with 12/30 orientation, 3,215 x 45 metres long (8,858 x 148 feet) at an elevation of 16 metres.

Terminals

The airport houses two passenger terminals: the Main Terminal building, divided into T1 and T2, where national and international flights operate; and the Regional Aviation Terminal, exclusively for local flights. There is also a General Aviation Terminal and a cargo terminal.

In 2020, the airport recorded 2,487,496 passages, 35,900 flights and 11,938 tons of cargo.

THE MEDITERRANEAN FOREST OF ESPADÁN AND THE CASTLE OF CASTRO

This experience is unique since walking this path from Alfondeguilla you feel the true essence of Espadán. Its landscapes speak to us of flora that is difficult to find in our territory, of well-preserved hydraulic heritage, of cultivation areas that are being colonized by the forest and, above all, of its inhabitants.

The inhabitants of these mountains and their remains invite us to look through these mountains as a window into the past where we can find our roots and connections to our current culture. It is recommended for people used to walking and children over 8 years old.

SPELEO KAYAKING AT SAN JOSÉ CAVES

Enjoy a fascinating experience exploring in kayak the longest navigable subterranean river in Europe, the San José caves. (Castellón). Speleo Kayaking is an activity that combines the enjoyment of kayaking with the excitement of discovering the wonders hidden in the interiors of the Earth provided by speleology (the scientific investigation of caves).

Equipped with wetsuits and accompanied by our professional guides, we will explore the amazing chambers of this unusual underground river situated on the edge of the Sierra Espadán Natural Park, a river full of marvellous geological formations.

HISTORY OF THE ROMANS: BENICATÓ DE NULES

In the hands of our archaeologist guide, we will discover this impressive Roman villa situated between orange groves in the town of Nules, one of the largest and best preserved of its kind in the region. We will learn about the inhabitants of our shire during the Roman Empire, daily life in these agrarian communities, transport links and other questions related to this fascinating archaeological site.

There will also be an educational workshop with a display of Roman ceramics and other daily utensils



THE MILLENNIAL OLIVE TREES AND THE LIQUID GOLD OF ARTANA

This easy 3 km route offers a fun day out for all the family. We will learn about the ancient trees that are still standing and provide us with one of the essential ingredients of the Mediterranean diet: olive oil. Another of the incentives to travel up to this village in the Sierra de Espadán, as you will have the chance to sample the oil, or liquid gold, of one of the 45 varieties of olive found in our region: the Serrana de Espadán.

It offers spectacular views over the town and its citrus fruit groves, with the Mediterranean Sea as its backdrop. The route includes two small bridges and an abseiling section. No experience necessary. What to bring? Comfortable clothing, climbing boots or trainers with soles in good condition, snacks and water.

DISCOVER SAN JOSÉ CAVES, A RIVER OF SENSATIONS

The San José caves offers the visitor a tranquil boat trip through the caves along one of the longest navigable subterranean rivers in the world.

The visit includes an 800m stretch on a boat and a 250m walk. This is the longest navigable subterranean river in Europe.

MOUNTAINS OF LA VILAVELLA: LANDSCAPE OF WAR

Walking through the interior of the trenches of the Civil War makes us imagine what the soldiers who took shelter in them went through. With this guided route, we will not only imagine, but we will also know the details of the day to day in the trench and we will share documents, plans, photographs and other materials. We will visit the scars that the war left on our mountains, visiting the remains of the military camp and the trenches and machine gun nests used by the two armies. We will discover, in an incredible environment, the war heritage of our mountains that we can, and must, still know today.







and Ángela García de Paredes, created a unique building, with an asymmetric design, characterized by the large latticework entrance, providing shade, which leads to a hall decorated with handcrafted ceramics. Housing a hall with a capacity for 700 guests, the roof is a concrete structure, installed with state of the art acoustic insulation. The building also has an exhibition hall and three smaller rooms for conferences and conventions, with an upper and lower hall ranging between 450 and 650 m² offering a versatile space with abundant natural light.







Opening on April 1, 2004, the building, designed by Carlos Ferrater, is constructed from white concrete. It benefits from a sense of space and light as well as the 90,000 m² park which surrounds it.

It holds a symphonic hall with a capacity for 1,200 people, and an adaptable interior space for all types of performances. There is also a chamber room with a capacity of 350, dedicated to the famous Castellón guitarist Manuel Babiloni, designed for chamber music and smaller events. The building also has an exhibition hall, the Magic Box, a press room, restaurant and other multi-purpose locations for all types of cultural events.


